Born and bred in New York City, Monét X Change is an entertainment spitfire and the first double crown winner from *RuPaul's Drag Race*. Having earned the title Miss Congeniality on Season 10, she became the first queen of color inducted into the Hall of Fame after winning All-Stars 4. Known for delivering energetic and show-stopping performances, Monét's showmanship reflects a tireless work ethic. After her initial appearance on RuPaul's *Drag Race*, Monét released a début EP, *Unapologetically*, traveled around the globe with her one-woman show, *Call Me By Monét*, hosted her own talk show, *The X Change Rate*,

produced by Yahoo! and began focusing her oftentimes sociopolitical humor as the co-host of the popular podcast *Sibling Rivalry* with Bob the Drag Queen and Ebony and Irony, with the legendary Lady Bunny. During her run on RuPaul's *Drag Race All Stars*: All Winners, Monét shocked audiences with her rendition of "Vi ravviso, o luoghi ameni" from *La sonnambula*. Following this performance, Monét has been a featured vocalist with San Francisco Symphony and was recently featured as The Duchess of Krakenthorp in *Daughter of the Regiment* with Minnesota Opera. This season, she appears with Dayton Opera as a soloist in their concert, *Prince Orlofsky's Grand Masquerade*.
